- storing invoices in folders by date



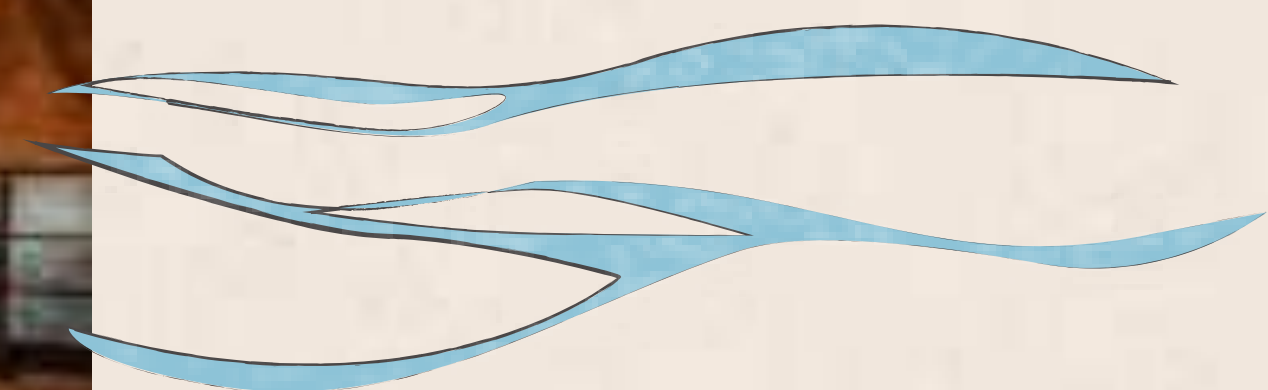
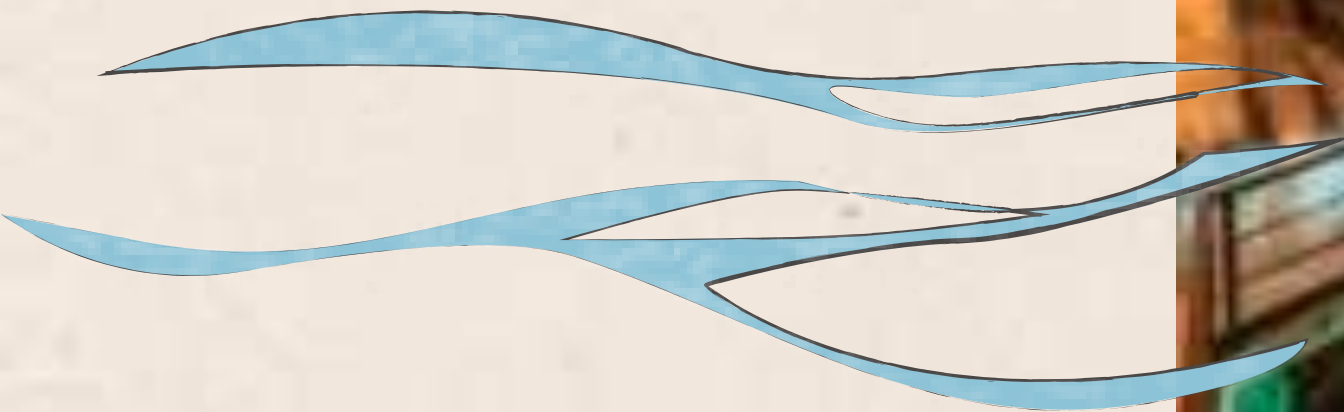
Tours
